

Glad tidings we bring

Thanks to each and every one of you, in 2023 we completed our £1 million Robot Appeal. This state of the art surgical robot is now in use and making a difference at Wycombe hospital. Our current appeals include the Spinal Surgery Appeal and newly launched, Lung Cancer Biopsy Appeal.

Spinal Surgery Appeal

We are currently fundraising for a spinal navigation and robotics platform, with endoscopic surgery capability for Wycombe hospital. The £1.1 million

Spinal Appeal will establish Buckinghamshire Healthcare NHS Trust as a regional centre for endoscopic spine surgery in the UK and make us only one of four sites to have this equipment within the country.

This exciting next step in robotic technology will benefit more people, bring faster recovery times and a quicker return home for those undergoing surgery.

Lung Cancer Biopsy Appeal

Our new Lung Cancer Biopsy Appeal for £150,000 will ensure people with suspected lung cancer have a quicker, safer and more accurate diagnosis.

The new appeal will introduce the innovative use of Peripheral Navigational Bronchoscopy to Stoke Mandeville hospital. Navigational bronchoscopy is performed using the latest, advanced technology which works like a GPS system. A three-dimensional roadmap of the lungs is created which allows clinicians to reach much deeper into the lungs. Clinicians can access the most distant regions of the lungs to detect and biopsy even the smallest lesions. Currently these suspected cancers are difficult to biopsy and patients may be referred to hospitals outside of Bucks for biopsy, which could lead to a delay in diagnosis.
